ARTWORK GUIDELINES

1. Create a colorful picture with the theme: “**OUT with the NEW, IN with the OLD**”. Artworks should reflect:

- How can you help to take care of the Earth and its resources to help support animal and plant life?
- What are some invasive species in Romeo? What are some indigenous species?
- Some Keywords to Consider:

Path	Trail	Neighborhood
Trash	Plant	Garden
Future	Recycle	Native Species
Compost	Stewardship	Leadership
Environment	Community	Volunteer
Green	Resources	Flowers
Insects	Trees	Sun

The image can be in the form of a drawing, painting, or “word painting”. **Crayons, markers, colored pencils, or poster paint (limited amount) may be used. Please do not use glue, glitter, sand, yarn or other materials that create texture.** All images must be dry and flat before submission so they can be easily scanned.

2. **Word Paintings** should be original work relating to the project theme. Word paintings should be written onto a colorful background and may also include images that are admissible for this project. All word paintings will be reviewed for language and content.
3. Artwork can be created on the blank side of the **Artwork Entry Form** included below (make copies of the Artwork Entry Form). You can also use any 11" x 8.5" paper (landscape orientation) as long as the student information from the form is written on the back.

NOTE: Please **DO NOT** include the following in the artwork:

- **Student Names** (please ask students to put their name on the back and not on the front of their drawings)
- **Paintings/photographs of people, copyrighted material, or inappropriate language/subject matter.**

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

1. Send home the **Letter to Parents/Consent Form** to be completed, signed and returned to the school. See Letter to Parents/Consent Form below.
2. Make sure all of the information on the **Artwork Entry Form** is completed for each artwork.
3. Include a signed Parent Consent Form for every artwork if possible.
4. Download the “**School Submission List**” spreadsheet from www.projectsnap.org/actionforearth/afedocuments.html and fill in the information in each column of the spreadsheet:

 - Teacher Last Name

The purpose of this letter is to share a wonderful opportunity for our students. We have been invited to participate in the **Project S.N.A.P. Mosaic Mural Program as part of Action for Earth**, a six-month environmental stewardship campaign in our community taking place between January 2010-June 2010. Funded by the Erb Family Foundation, this exciting pilot project is a collaboration between our community, our public library, Project S.N.A.P., and the Ann Arbor Hands-On Museum. Action for Earth strives to teach our students the science behind our environmental challenges and inspires them to become responsible environmental leaders.
