



I-SAVE 3.0 MOSAIC MURAL PROJECT



ARTWORK GUIDELINES

1. Create a colorful picture based on the theme: **“Energy and resource conservation at school and at home”**. Consider the following when creating your artwork:
 - What can you do to conserve your use of energy at school?
 - What can you do to conserve your use of energy at home?
 - What can you do to help protect our natural resources?
 - How can you help conserve water and keep our lakes and rivers clean?
 - What is your favorite plant or animal? What does their habitat look like? What can you do to help protect their habitat?
 - How does litter negatively impact plants and wildlife? What can you do to keep your school and neighborhood clean?
 - Why is it important to take care of the Earth and its resources?

The image can be in the form of a drawing, painting, or a decorated written message. **If possible, please use markers or colored pencils only. Please try to avoid crayons, pastels, glue, glitter, sand, yarn or other materials that can rub off or create texture.** All images must be dry and flat before submission so they can be easily scanned.

2. **Messages** should be written onto a colorful background and may also include images that are admissible for this project. All messages will be reviewed for language and content.
3. **Artwork should be created on the blank side of the Artwork Entry Form in landscape/horizontal orientation.** Artworks submitted in the portrait/vertical orientation may be cropped in order to fit into the mosaic. Student information should be written on the back in the space provided. Please make sure the information on the back of the form is written clearly so that every student artwork can be catalogued correctly by Project S.N.A.P.

NOTE: Please **DO NOT** include the following in the artwork:

- **Student Names** (No names on the front of the artwork please! Instruct your students that they will be recognized as the artist in the *Online Art Museum* as long as their names are written clearly on the back of their Artwork Entry Form.)
- **Paintings/photographs of people, copyrighted material, or inappropriate language/subject matter.**

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

1. Send home the **Parent Flyer** about the project. Collect any email addresses parents send in with their students.
2. Make sure all of the information on the **Artwork Entry Form** is completed for each artwork.
3. Submit all artworks created by students. You may also include your own artwork if you would like to participate. Contact Project S.N.A.P. at isave@projectsnap.org with the names of any students whose parents have contacted the school directly specifying that that they do not want their child to participate.
4. Return the original artworks to your **I-Save Mosaic Mural Project Building Coordinator**.
